#### **19 February**

Dr. Kwaku, historian/musicologist, delivers his critically acclaimed lecture on the Afrikan presence and accomplishments around the world. It will reveal information that negates any notion of Afrikan inferiority, which educational institutions refuse to include in their curriculums.

#### **26 February**

Dr. Ivan Van Sertima, anthropologist/linguist, provides one of the most potent lectures he has ever delivered on Kemet (Egyptian) contributions and the need for people of Afrikan descent to evolve their consciousness. As many attempt to find their Afrikan spirituality and personality, see how documentarian Thomas Allen Harris travels to Afrika and Brazil to do just that.

#### **5 March**

Dr. Charles B. Copher, the godfather of Black biblical scholars, presents his groundbreaking lecture, “Black People In And Of The Bible.” He reveals what many pastors refuse to address, including the so-called curse. Also, see the life and times of musical genius, Thomas Dorsey, the father of gospel music.

#### **12 March**

We will look at the Haitian Revolution, which affected the entire western world, with the specific details before, during and after. Peru has a number of pyramids that imitate those of ancient Kemet (Egypt). We will see this glorious story for the first time.

#### **19 March**

Little is known about who were the first real Americans, Native Americans and the Chinese connection. This revolutionary information will be exposed. Dr. Kwaku shows his musicologist side by presenting his detailed lecture on “The History of Rasta and Reggae.”

#### **26 March**

Dr. Martin Bernal, linguist and specialist in Near Eastern Studies, wrote *Black Athena*, with the thesis that Afrikans in the Nile Valley influenced Greek civilization. See if his argument convincingly explains this perspective. We will also see the lives of those Afrikans who were the descendants of the first human beings.

**2 April**

Pastor, Dr. Ray Hagins, behavioral scientist, delivers one of the most controversial religious lectures that could turn the Christian world upside down: "The Nicea Conference - The creation of Jesus Christ." Devout Christians are asked not to attend this class. Also, we will look at David Robinson, son of Jackie Robinson, and his vital work in Afrika.

**9 April**

We will take a complete look at the slave trade from Afrika, the Caribbean, Europe, the financial institutions that supported it, ending in America. We will also look at the colonial period, particularly Southeast Afrika, and how Europeans used all of their resources to control the continent.

**16 April**

Who is responsible for the trans-Atlantic slave trade? Dr. Tony Martin, historian, gives us one of the most explosive lectures on this topic, the reason he was viciously attacked by academia and the mass media. We will also take an intimate look at the Black Seminole Native Americans.

**23 April**

There has been extreme violent turmoil in West Afrika due to the diamond trade. Terms such as "conflict diamonds" and/or "blood diamonds" have been used widely in the media and movie industry. We will look at the facts causing this tragedy.

**30 April**

The last class lesson will remain open for historical/cultural developments. We will also enjoy our culmination program for students.
